Jr. Beta Requirements and Guidelines

National Beta Club Mission Statement: To promote the ideals of academic achievement, character, service and leadership among elementary and secondary school students. To reward meritorious achievement and to encourage and assist students in continuing their education after high school.

*New or Returning Members

A student must maintain grades that meet Beta Requirements for a full semester prior to being invited for Jr Beta Membership.

Students must maintain a six-weeks average above 85 in every academic subject (Math, Reading, Language, Science, Social Studies).

Students must maintain an overall average of 90 for each six-weeks, excluding PE/Health.

* Probation

Probation results from failure to meet the grade requirements and gives students a semester period to bring their grades within the required range.

A second semester below the requirements will result in dismissal from the Jr Beta Club for a full academic semester at which time their grades can be reevaluated.

Students must demonstrate respect towards faculty and students.

Infractions will result in dismissal from the Jr Beta Club for a full academic semester.

Infractions include but are not limited to: ISS, OSS, etc.

Dismissal from Jr Beta will result in ineligibility for the Jr Beta Convention and/or trips, regardless of fund-raising activities and/or payments.

Any trips may be restricted to active members only.

National fees of \$15 are paid at induction (usually 6th grade).

* Officers

Officers shall be elected by currently inducted members.

If an officer is dismissed the remaining officers shall divide his or her duties.

President---Assist in meeting and activity organization and planning

Vice President---Member Activities

Secretary---Take minutes of meetings

Reporter---Scrapbook and pictures

Chaplain---Prayer Meetings at Convention, Community Service

Student Council Representative---Serve on Student Council
